

Notice of Race for the 2010 Tripp Memorial Race

1.0 RULES

The Tripp Memorial Race will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US Sailing), the rules and regulations of LMPHRF, and the Tripp Memorial Sailing Instructions.

2.0 ALTERATIONS OF CLASS RULES

There will be no alterations to the prescribed LMPHRF rules.

3.0 ADVERTISING

This event is classified as a category A event in accordance with RRS rule #79 on Advertising and Appendix G.

4.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

This race is open to all seaworthy sailing yachts. All classes will be allowed to race with spinnakers. Class divisions will be determined after receipt of all entries.

4.1 All yachts wishing to enter the race must have a valid and current PHRF certificate and a minimum of \$300,000 of liability insurance. It is not required to submit these with the entry.

5.0 RACE

Wednesday, June 23, 2010 at 7:00 PM (EDT) First start

6.0 REGISTRATION, FEES, SKIPPER'S MEETING

Enter by completing entry form (available @ www.lmsrf.org/area4/events.asp) and paying fees. Entry fee is \$75.00. Last date to enter is June 23, 2010.

All entered vessels should check in by 6:00 PM June 23, 2010. Either the Captain or designated representative of the vessel may complete this.

It is highly recommended that either the Captain or representative of all entered vessels attend the Skippers' Meeting.

Skipper's meeting will be held on the lawn of the Grand River Sail Club in Grand Haven at 5:30 PM, June 23, 2010

7.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available the skipper's meeting.

8.0 COURSE

Grand Haven, Michigan to Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

9.0 SCORING

Scoring shall be the low point system as shown in the current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing.

10.0 PROTESTS

Protests shall be submitted in writing to the Tripp Memorial Committee at the South Shore Yacht Club not more than two hours after finishing.

11.0 PENALTIES

Penalties shall be assessed in accordance with the current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing.

12.0 DECISIONS OF THE JURY

Decisions of the jury are final. Any determinations made after the presentation of awards shall have no effect on those awards.

13.0 PRIZES

Thursday following the race, awards will be presented at the South Shore Yacht Club to the overall winner and to yachts finishing first, second, and third section (subject to the number of boats in each section).

14.0 EQUIPMENT

Every yacht shall carry life-saving equipment conforming to government regulations.

15.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the Tripp Memorial entirely at their own risk. The decision to race is the sole responsibility of the Captain or Person in Charge. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Tripp Memorial Race
